

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DISPOS-ALL WASTE SYSTEMS OF OHIO, INC. FOR REFUSE COLLECTION WITHIN THE VILLAGE DURING THE YEAR 1992 AND, AT THE VILLAGE'S OPTION, 1993 AND 1994 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received by the Service Director for refuse collection with the Village, a tabulation of which bids is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Dispos-All Waste Systems of Ohio, Inc. for refuse collection within the Village during the year 1992 with the Village's option of renewing the agreement for 1993 and 1994 with curbside recycling collection on a bi-weekly basis to be commenced at the earliest possible time, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Dispos-All Waste Systems of Ohio, Inc. for refuse collection within the Village consistent with the bid, which agreement shall be acceptable to the Law Director.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the current refuse collection contract is due to expire on December 1, 1991; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council appointed or elected, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and
