RESOLUTION 69-1991

Offered by All Members of Council and Mayor Waszak

**A RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO *LeRoy J. Smith* FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AS A MEMBER OF COUNCIL AND A VOLUNTEER FIREMAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS:** *LeRoy J. Smith* began his Public Service to the citizens of the Village of Richfield on January 4, 1961, when he joined the Richfield Fire Department as a Volunteer Firefighter; and

**WHEREAS:** *LeRoy J. Smith* was promoted to the rank of Assistant Fire Chief on February 17, 1964, after driving the Fire Department's new 1963 fire truck in the Clinton Parade, and returning it on the back of a tow truck; and

**WHEREAS:** *LeRoy J. Smith* continued his firefighting, and driving skills with the Richfield Fire Department for more than twelve and one-half years, resigning September 7, 1973; and

**WHEREAS:** *LeRoy J. Smith* was elected to Council for the term beginning January 1, 1984, and was elected for a second term beginning January 1, 1988; and

**WHEREAS:** *LeRoy J. Smith* has served his community on numerous Council Committees, has given freely of his time to insure an honest, honorable, and responsive government to our citizens, and always remained a good neighbor and very good friend to all.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** The Council of the Village of Richfield commends and applauds *LeRoy J. Smith's* distinguished service to our community.


**SECTION 2:** This Council is assured that *LeRoy* will continue his excellent service to our community in his newly elected position of Richfield Township Trustee.
