

A RESOLUTION DECLARING COUNCIL'S INTENT TO ACCEPT A
PROPOSED ANNEXATION TO THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain property owners have filed a peti-
tion with the Summit County Council proposing an annexation of
approximately 105.87 acres currently in Richfield Township to the
Village of Richfield, a copy of which Petition is attached hereto
as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference;
and

WHEREAS, a hearing on the proposed annexation has
been scheduled before the Summit County Council for July 2, 1990;
and

WHEREAS, if the annexation is approved by the Summit
County Council, this Council will, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code
Section 709.04, have sixty (60) days within which to accept or
reject the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to go on record declar-
ing its intent to accept the proposed annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the
Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That this Council hereby declares its intent to ac-
cept dedication of the proposed annexation of 105.87
acres from Richfield Township into the Village of
Richfield as indicated on Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public health, safety and welfare and for the
further reason to be effect by the July 2nd hearing
and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative
vote of two-thirds of the members elected or ap-
pointed, it shall take effect and be in force from
and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it
shall take effect and be in force from and after the
earliest date provided law.
