

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD WITH RESPECT TO PROVIDING A SAFETY TOWN PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the Township of Richfield with respect to a Safety Town Program.


SECTION 2: The form of the contract, now on file in the Office of the Director of Public Service, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide authority for contract action, and, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.



AGREEMENT

The Village of Richfield, Ohio and the Township of Richfield, Ohio, both in Summit County, agree as to the following:

1. The Village of Richfield will provide a Safety Town program for the purpose of providing safety education to pre-school children.
2. The Village of Richfield will provide and pay for facilities, materials, personnel and other ordinary costs and expenses for the Safety Town program.
3. The program will be made available during that time of the year that the Revere School System is closed for summer vacation.
4. The Safety Town program will be made available to the children of all Township residents.
5. The Township of Richfield will, for and on behalf of the Township residents who participate in the Safety Town program, pay the actual cost of the Township residents participation.
6. Actual cost, for purpose of this agreement, will include all costs of facilities, materials, equipment, personnel, and all other usual and ordinary expenses. The actual cost will be determined by the Village of Richfield Finance Director after the completion of the annual Safety Town program. The total cost of the program will be divided by the number of children attending to provide a per-person cost. That per-person cost will be multiplied by the number of Richfield Township residents that attended the Safety Town program to determine the total actual cost.
7. The Director of Finance will, within a reasonable time after the completion of the Annual Safety Town Program, provide a full and complete accounting of the program to the Township of Richfield, and the Township will, within forty-five days thereafter, pay to the Village of Richfield the actual cost of Township participation.
8. This agreement is subject to adjustment by mutual consent.
9. This agreement is made pursuant to the terms of Village Ordinance 66-1190 and Richfield Township Resolution _____.
10. The Township of Richfield represents that the funds necessary to pay the obligation created by this Agreement are on deposit or have been appropriated and are in the process of collection.

11. This Agreement supersedes any prior agreement made by the Village and Township with respect to the program.
