

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION AS DULY SERVED AND INDICATING THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE PROPOSED ANNEXED TERRITORY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

May Property

WHEREAS, by letter dated August 1, 1990, Lynn Leary, Esq., agent for Petitioners to annex approximately 105 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, notified the Village of Richfield that the Petition was filed with the Summit County Council at their meeting of July 2, 1990; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with O.R.C. 709.01, a hearing has been scheduled for Monday, September 17, 1990; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with 709.031 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council wishes to acknowledge receipt of the Petition and to indicate the services to be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: That this Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the Petition for Annexation of 105 Acres in the Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, which Petition was accepted for filing by the Summit County Council at their meeting on July 2, 1990.


SECTION 2: This Council hereby indicates that all Village services, including, but not limited to, police, fire, service and garbage will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

SECTION 3: That this Council hereby declares its intent to accept dedication of the proposed annexation when presented pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 709.04.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason to be effective by the September 17, 1990 hearing before the Summit County Council and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
