

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR WATER LINE CONSTRUCTION FROM TOWNSEND ROAD TO BRUSH ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized to advertise for bids for water line construction from Townsend Road to Brush Road in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Village Engineer now on file with such Director of Public Service.


Section 2: The plans and specifications for such water line construction referred to in Section 1 are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for the water line construction with the lowest bidder after advertising according to law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason that the water line construction is urgently needed and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
