

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO YELLOW FREIGHT SYSTEMS FOR USE OF OVERSIZED TRUCKS ON TO BRECKSVILLE ROAD BETWEEN ITS TERMINAL FACILITY AND OHIO TURNPIKE EXIT 11 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Yellow Freight Systems desires to operate trucks on Brecksville Road between its terminal facility and Ohio Turnpike Gate 11; and

WHEREAS, Brecksville Road in this location is a four lane State highway with an additional turning lane; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has issued a permit to Yellow Freight Systems to use oversized vehicles on the Ohio Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police believes that, under certain conditions, the utilization of oversized vehicles on Brecksville Road between Ohio Turnpike Gate 11 and the Yellow Freight facility would not adversely affect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code Section 4513.34 and Richfield Traffic Code Section 339.02(b) permits the Chief of Police to issue special permits for oversized vehicles on local streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Chief of Police be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a permit to Yellow Freight Systems to utilize Brecksville Road for oversized vehicles between Ohio Turnpike Gate No. 11 and their terminal warehouse facilities upon the following conditions:


- (1) The permit shall not exceed one (1) year at which time it will be necessary for Yellow Freight to apply for a renewal.
- (2) The oversized vehicles shall only utilize Brecksville Road between Ohio Turnpike Gate No. 11 and the Yellow Freight facility.
- (3) The permit may be revoked at any time subject to the order of the Chief of Police.

- (4) Hours of operation for the oversized vehicles shall not occur during rush hour; i.e., between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- (5) The oversized vehicles shall not operate during extreme snowy or icy or other inclement weather conditions.
- (6) The Chief of Police may suspend the permit at any time in his sole discretion due to road or traffic conditions.


SECTION 2: The Chief of Police shall cause signs to be posted to apprise Yellow Freight drivers of the limitations imposed by this permit. No Yellow Freight driver shall disobey the instructions indicated on such signs.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to coordinate with the permit received from the Ohio Department of Transportation; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
