

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF ROTH ENTERPRISES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF VARIOUS SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 2 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, on November 21, 1990, bids were taken for the construction of various sanitary sewer improvements in connection with Sanitary Sewer District No. 2; and

WHEREAS, after tabulation of said bids, Richfield's Consulting Engineer, Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Ltd., has recommended acceptance of the bid of Roth Enterprises as being the lowest and best bid in the total amount of \$1,490,822.11.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Roth Enterprises in the amount of \$1,490,822.11 for sewer improvements in connection with Sanitary Sewer District No. 2, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Roth Enterprises consistent with their bid, which contract shall be approved by Richfield's Consulting Engineer and Law Director.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reasons that the sanitary sewer improvements are immediately necessary to protect the public health; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
