A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RICHFIELD PARK BOARD TO PURCHASE MATERIALS NEEDED TO BRING THE BASEBALL EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD UP TO A SAFE, USABLE CONDITION

WHEREAS, the baseball equipment owned and maintained by the Village of Richfield has deteriorated through time and use, has not been upgraded for several years, and has been found to need substantial repair and replenishment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the Village of Richfield hereby authorizes the Service Director, in consultation with the Park Board, of the Village of Richfield to purchase materials needed to bring the baseball equipment owned by the Village of Richfield up to a safe, usable condition at a cost not to exceed \$3,500.00.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to bring the baseball equipment owned by the Village of Richfield up to a safe, usable condition and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
