

RESOLUTION NO. 75-1989

Offered by Mayor Waszak and Mr. Nehrenz

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR AN ADDITION TO THE SERVICE BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for an addition to the Service Building in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Reinboldt, Evans & Mann, Inc., as authorized by Resolution 23-1989.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to advertise for prompt construction of the addition to the Service Building and provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest dated provided by law.
