

ORDINANCE NO. 85-1989

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 145.07 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ESTABLISHING A DAILY STORAGE RATE FOR IMPOUNDED CARS STORED ON THE VILLAGE PREMISES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 145.07 of the Administrative Code be enacted to read as follows:

"145.07 CHARGES FOR STORAGE OF IMPOUNDED CARS.

Any person, firm, corporation or other entity whose motor vehicle is impounded by the Police Department and stored on Village property shall be charged Five Dollars (\$5.00) per day or part thereof for storage. The Mayor shall have the authority to waive the foregoing charges under such terms and conditions as are reasonable and proper."

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
