WHEREAS: Activities are being planned for a special celebration at all the schools and the Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio urge all citizens to participate in the celebration, and

WHEREAS: School spirit should be encouraged and promoted to show that we are proud of our children, our schools, and our community.

Section 1: NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio in full support of this promotion and desiring to recognize this celebration, do hereby proclaim:

in the Village of Richfield with the hope that throughout the Revere School District everyone will share experiences and gain better understanding.
