

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT FOR DISPATCH PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of Communication Equipment for Dispatch purposes in accordance with plans and specifications now on file with such Director of Public Service.

Section 2: The plans and specifications for said Communication Equipment for Dispatch purposes referred to in Section 1 are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for the purchase of such Communication Equipment for Dispatch purposes with the lowest and best bidder after advertising according to law.

Section 4: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason that Communication Equipment for Dispatch purposes are urgently needed for municipal services and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
