

ORDINANCE 33-1988

AN ORDINANCE REENACTING SECTIONS 331.34 AND 333.08 OF THE TRAFFIC CODE ~~AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.~~

WHEREAS, Section 331.34(a) of the Richfield Traffic Code (Failure to Control) was eliminated on March 15, 1983 and reenacted as Section 333.08; and

WHEREAS, this Council, upon the advice of the Akron Prosecutor wishes to reenact Sections 331.34 and 333.08 with proper titles.

Now, therefore, Be It Ordained By the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That Sections 331.34 and 333.08 be reenacted to read as follows:

"331.34 FAILURE TO CONTROL; OPERATING WITHOUT WEAVING; FULL TIME AND ATTENTION

(a) * * *

(b) No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle upon any street or highway in a weaving or zigzag course unless such irregular course is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.

(c) No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle without giving his full time and attention to the operation of such vehicle.

333.08 FAILURE TO CONTROL; OPERATING WITHOUT REASONABLE CONTROL

No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street, highway or property open to the public for vehicular traffic without being in reasonable control of the vehicle."

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason of the enforcement of law and provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
