

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE AREAWIDE SERVICES STUDY IN SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, A JOINT VENTURE OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AND CENTER FOR URBAN STUDIES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF AKRON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

WHEREAS: This regional services study is designed to examine the adequacy of the various public services throughout Summit County and to propose alternative approaches to improve services on the regional level where indicated, and

WHEREAS: The future economic health of the Summit County area will be largely determined by the quality of public services provided throughout the county.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio


Section 1: The Council of The Village of Richfield, Ohio hereby offers its cooperation to the Summit County Council of Governments and the Center for Urban Studies at the University of Akron in carrying out the regional services project. It also supports them in their efforts to secure the necessary private funding for this joint venture.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that this legislation complies with Section 97.22 of the Ohio Revised Code regarding notification of meetings and all deliberations of the Council of the Village of Richfield pertaining hereto have been conducted in accordance therewith.

Section 3: This resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason of allowing the area wide services study to proceed and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
