A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to House Bill 100, the Department of Administrative Services sponsors a Cooperative Purchasing Program for political subdivisions of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is desirous of participating in this Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to participate in the Cooperative Purchasing Program sponsored by the Department of Administrative Services.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety to save taxpayer dollars and providing this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
