A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation sponsors a Cooperative Purchasing Program for political subdivisions of the State pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(b); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Richfield is desirous of participating in this Program.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to participate in the Cooperative Purchasing Program sponsored by the Ohio Department of Transportation pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01(b).

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety to save taxpayer money and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
