


A RESOLUTION TO CONGRATULATE HILLCREST PRIMARY SCHOOL

- SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield hereby give public recognition to the teachers, students and administration of Hillcrest Primary School for being named an outstanding elementary school in the United States, and
- SECTION 2: The Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield hereby congratulate Hillcrest Primary School on behalf of all the residents of Richfield for its high quality standards which enabled the school to earn this award of distinction, and
- SECTION 3: Richfield is proud of the strong commitment to educational excellence evidenced by this Award and encourages parents, teachers, and students to pledge continued support for the ultimate benefit of our community and our country.


