

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE (25) ALERT MONITORS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of not more than 25 Alert Monitors for the Fire Department.

Section 2: The plans and specifications for such Alert Monitors, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for such Alert Monitors after advertising according to law.

Section 4: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason the Alert Monitors are needed for vital municipal services and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
