

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO RECEIVE A TRANSFER OF LAND FROM THE EAST OHIO GAS COMPANY FOR CEMETERY GROUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the East Ohio Gas Company has made an offer to transfer certain lands to this Village and the Village intends to use those lands for cemetery purposes and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended the Village accept the transfer on certain terms and conditions,

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


- Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to accept a Warranty Deed from the East Ohio Gas Company for lands described and surveyed by the Municipal Engineer in September of 1986, that description now being on file in the office of the Director of Public Service.
- Section 2: The lands described and transferred are to be used for cemetery purposes, with the right reserved to change the use thereof in accordance with the public interest.
- Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to accept the terms of the transfer as those terms are described in a letter dated March 12, 1987 from the East Ohio Gas Company, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide cemetery space urgently needed and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect


and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
