

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY TO PAY THE TUITION COSTS AND MILEAGE FOR PARAMEDIC TRAINING FOR ROBERT JONES FOR REIMBURSEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Robert Jones is a Volunteer Fireman for this Village and this Village desires for him to qualify as a ~~Fire~~ ^{PARA-} Medic and the Village desires to pay tuition and mileage therefore under certain conditions,


Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

- Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to pay the necessary and actual costs of tuition and mileage in order for Robert Jones to qualify as a ~~Fire~~ ^{PARA-} Medic, as an advancement.
- Section 2: If, after certification and qualification, Robert Jones remains employed by this Village as a Volunteer Fireman or is employed as a ~~Fire~~ ^{PARA-} Medic and is employed on a continuous basis for a period of 18 months, there shall be no requirement to pay to this Village the amount of the advancement for tuition and mileage, however, in the event such employment and the term thereof is less than 18 months, then and in that event, the Director of Finance shall collect and Robert Jones shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the amount of such advances on a basis prorated as to time of employment and 18 months.
- Section 3: A failure by Robert Jones to complete the training or to qualify shall require him to pay this Village the full cost of the advancement.
- Section 4: The terms and conditions of this Resolution shall be binding on Robert Jones upon his endorsing his approval on a copy of this Resolution to be kept and maintained by the Director of Finance.
- Section 5: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide adequate training and advancements and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from


and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
