

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, OHIO IN UNDERTAKING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is interested in the Community Development Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village to obtain funds to achieve such goals and objectives as provided by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, the act encourages municipalities to enter into Agreements of Cooperation with the County regarding said Act; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has expressed its desire to qualify as an Urban County under the provisions of the aforementioned Act;

THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement of Cooperation with the County of Summit, Ohio, for the purpose of undertaking essential community development activities, a copy of which is attached hereto.


Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide necessary funds and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the

Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest date provided by law.
