

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT OR AGREEMENTS OF INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of insurance in the following forms:

1. Property and Casualty
2. General Liability
3. General Auto Liability
4. Physical Damage - Auto
5. Professional Liability
6. Umbrella Coverage
7. Inland Marine Coverage

Section 2: The specifications for such insurances now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service are hereby approved.


Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for such insurances with the lowest and best bidder or bidders after advertising according to law.


Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason that the expiring date of present coverages are imminent and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor;

otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
