

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT THE USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES ASSIGNED TO THE DIVISION OF POLICE FOR CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL PURPOSES, TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, police officers of this Village are from time to time requested to perform traffic control duties for non governmental entities and,

WHEREAS, those officers on an off duty basis execute those duties at no cost to this Village and are compensated by those entities for the work and labor and,

WHEREAS, from time to time motor vehicles assigned to the Division of Police are not needed for service by police officers who are on duty and,

WHEREAS, the presence of those motor vehicles, on the road or at rest is an effective deterrent to the violation of the laws relating to the operation of motor vehicles and,

WHEREAS, the combined presence of off duty police officers and motor vehicles assigned to the Division of Police within the Village will promote adherence to the law and deter crime and,

WHEREAS, non governmental entities have expressed a willingness to pay this Village a reasonable sum for the presence of those motor vehicles,

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Chief of the Division of Police is authorized to permit the presence of motor vehicles assigned to the Division of Police to points and places within the Village on condition that (1) an off duty police officer is in control of the vehicle and (2) the motor vehicle is not needed for usual and ordinary police purposes and (3) appropriate financial arrangements are made with any non governmental entity and (4) the presence of the vehicle is for traffic control purposes.


Section 2: The schedule of such rates and charges for the presence of the motor vehicles referred to in Section 1 hereof, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service is found to be compensatory to this

Village and shall be paid by the non governmental entities for the presence of the motor vehicle.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide an additional means of reducing general motor vehicle traffic offenses and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
