

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPORT OF THE ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD ON OBJECTIONS CONCERNING THE ESTIMATED SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTIES IN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD BY CONSTRUCTING SANITARY SEWERS, TOGETHER WITH SERVICE CONNECTIONS, AND SANITARY SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS, TOGETHER WITH THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO, IN CERTAIN DESIGNATED LOCATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Assessment Equalization Board appointed by Resolution No. 46-1987 adopted November 4, 1987, to hear and determine all objections to the estimated special assessments for the improvement of certain properties in the Village of Richfield by constructing sanitary sewers, together with service connections, and sanitary sewage pumping stations, together with the necessary appurtenances thereto, in certain designated locations in accordance with Resolution No. 41-1987 adopted on September 3, 1987, as amended by Resolution No. 43-1987 adopted on September 29, 1987, has filed its report with this Council as to its determination of the objections; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed that report and deems it proper in all respects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The report of the Assessment Equalization Board referred to in the preambles to this resolution is approved. The estimated special assessments as reported by the Board shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of Council.
- Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- Section 3. This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of this Village and for the further reason that this resolution is required to be immediately effective to provide for the construction of the improvement described above, which is needed to eliminate existing hazards to the health and property of the residents of the Village; wherefore, this resolution

shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
