

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 715.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY PROHIBITING HOME SOLICITATION SALES TO CERTAIN HOURS.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 715.02 of the Codified Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

715.02 LICENSE: ISSUANCE; REVOCATION; DISPLAY.

(a) Upon the furnishing of the information required under Section 715.01(a), and the payment of the application fee, the applicant shall be issued a license forthwith by the Chief of Police, unless the information furnished in compliance with this chapter shows that the applicant has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude.

(b) Any license granted hereunder may be revoked by the Chief of Police for furnishing false information in connection with the registrant's application, or for the subsequent conviction of the registrant for a crime involving moral turpitude, or upon proof that the applicant has been guilty of disorderly conduct, fraud or misrepresentation in connection with his business, or for the violation of any ordinance of the Village. Each license shall expire on the day and at the time so specified in the individual license as issued.

(c) Solicitors are required to exhibit their license at the request of any resident.

(d) No person shall solicit between the hours of sunset and sunrise as those times are determined and published as the Local Climatological Data Monthly Summary by the U.S. Department of Commerce, National Climatic Data Center, Federal Building, Ashville, North Carolina 28801.

Section 2: Existing Section 715.02 of the Codified Ordinances is repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
