

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP IN COUNTY-UNIVERSITY AND EDUCATIONAL COOPERATIVE AND PURCHASING ASSOCIATION (CUE) AND TO OTHERWISE USE THE SERVICES OF CUE WHERE THE INTERESTS OF THIS VILLAGE ARE BEST SERVED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County-University and Educational Cooperative and Purchasing Association (CUE) is and has been organized for the purpose of providing bulk purchasing benefits to and for public authorities and political subdivisions in Summit County, and

WHEREAS, the services of CUE are or may be beneficial with respect to the purchase of materials and supplies required for the operation of this Village, and

WHEREAS, the interests of this Village will be served by membership in CUE and the use of the services,

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to do all things and take all steps necessary and appropriate to apply for membership in County-University and Educational Cooperative and Purchasing Association (CUE).


Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are further authorized and directed to use the services of CUE where appropriate, in the interest of the Village of Richfield and where authorized by law.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason that the economic interest of this Village may be served and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
