

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TUCHMAN-CANUTE ARCHITECTS INCORPORATED FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR THE INTERIOR DESIGN OF THE COUNCIL MEETING ROOM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a need and Council proposes to design the Council Chambers, and

WHEREAS, the design of Council Chambers involves the rendition of architectural service, a personal service which requires peculiar skill and ability and which is exempt from the usual requirement of competitive bidding,

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council finds and determines that architectural services which are personal services and require peculiar skills and abilities, are exempt from the usual requirement for competitive bidding.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Tuchman-Canute Architects Incorporated for provision of architectural services for the design of Council Chambers and they are authorized and directed to pay for such services from the proper accounts on presentation of proof of service. The form of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is hereby approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to take advantage of the building season and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
