

RESOLUTION NO. 10-2013

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A NEW VEHICLE FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM SERPENTINI CHEVROLET THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO PURCHASING PROGRAM AND TO PURCHASE EMERGENCY LIGHTS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT FOR THE VEHICLE AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase a 2013 Chevy Tahoe as a special services vehicle for the Fire Department under the State Purchasing Program from Serpentine Chevrolet; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to purchase emergency lights and other equipment for the vehicle from Fallsway Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to purchase a communications radio for the vehicle from Motorola.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase a 2013 Chevy Tahoe as a special services vehicle for the Fire Department from Serpentine Chevrolet for a total amount not to exceed \$33,000.00, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program.
- SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase emergency lights and other equipment for the special services vehicle from Fallsway Equipment for a total amount not to exceed \$5,400.00.
- SECTION 3. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase a communications radio for the special services vehicle from Motorola for a total amount not to exceed \$3,000.00.
- SECTION 4. That the Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate from the Fire Equipment Fund: Cost of Operations \$41,400.00 for the purchases set forth in Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Resolution.
- SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to acquire a new truck to facilitate the provision of fire protection services at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
