

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 153.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING ANNIVERSARY DATES FOR ~~THE FIRE DIVISION, THE POLICE DIVISION, THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD, OHIO, AND THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO, BY DEFINING REFERENCES TO FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.~~ . FULL-TIME

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 153.01 of the Codified Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

153.01 BUDGET AND RECORDS; DEFINITIONS.

(a) Budget and Records. An employee is a person who has been appointed to perform a job title created by the Charter or ordinances except elected public officials. The Mayor shall cause the head of each Department of this Municipality to submit annually a budget for the ensuing year. The Director of Finance shall be responsible for the records of all employees' benefits included in this chapter.

(b) Definitions. The following offices are defined as follows:

- (1) "Elected official" means a person who has been elected to an office created by the Charter.
- (2) "Contract employee" means a person who has been employed to perform specialized and personal services for the Village under the authority of an ordinance.

(c) Anniversary Date. The anniversary date shall be the date an employee began full-time employment. Length of service shall be computed from the anniversary date, for benefits. If an employee resigns and is later reinstated or reemployed, the date of reinstatement or reemployment shall constitute a new anniversary date. Persons employed by the Township of Richfield before incorporation shall have as their anniversary date the date of such employment by the Township. ~~For purposes of this subsection, the anniversary date for the incumbent Chief of the Division of Police shall be December 23, 1964 and the anniversary date for the incumbent Chief of the Division of Fire shall be February 1, 1964.~~ The anniversary dates for all full-time employees shall be maintained by the Mayor & a record of such certification will be maintained by the Finance Director.

Section 2: Existing Section 153.01 of the Codified Ordinances is repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to correct records and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect


and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
