

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; TO REPEAL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Justinian Publishing Company has completed its updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the Village; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature that have been passed by Council since the date of the last updating of the Codified Ordinances of the Villages; and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring Village law into conformity with State Law; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of this Village, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances:

Section 3: That all ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof that are in conflict with any of the provisions of the new matter approved, adopted and enacted by Section 2 hereof are hereby repealed, except as follows:

(a) The enactment of such new matter shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision or to affect an indictment or prosecution therefor. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purposes of revision and recodification.

(b) The repeal provided above shall not affect any legislation enacted after June 2, 1986.

Section 4: That pursuant to Section 4.11 of the Charter and Section 123.01 of the Codified Ordinances, the Clerk of Council shall post a copy of this ordinance in the public places as set forth in Section 123.01, together with notice as to where sets of the 1986 Replacement Pages for the Codified Ordinances of the Village, hereby approved, adopted and enacted, may be examined by the public.

Section 5: The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to transmit and deliver a copy of the foregoing Codified Ordinances to the Summit County Law Library.

Section 6: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason of the need to have a codification of the laws of the Village that is up-to-date and consistent with State Law, as required by the Ohio Constitution, and with which to administer the affairs of the Village and to ensure law and order, and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its

approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
