

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A RESCUE VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of one rescue vehicle and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase thereof after advertising according to law.

Section 2: The specifications for the rescue vehicle, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are hereby approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide equipment for which there is a need and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
