

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE 9-1-1 RECOMMENDED IMPLEMENTATION PLAN OF MAY 1986. <sup>AND DETAIL RE: AN EMERGENCY</sup>

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has received the 9-1-1 Recommended Implementation Plan, dated May, 1986, wherein there is described the use of emergency telephone number 9-1-1 throughout Summit County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Plan can only be implemented upon the approval of sixty percent (60%) of the population of Summit County, as represented by the several Councils of the municipalities within the County; and

WHEREAS, the plan was approved by the Summit County 9-1-1 Planning Committee on June 16, 1986; and

WHEREAS, this Council has reviewed the 9-1-1 Recommended Implementation Plan dated May, 1986, and finds that the plan meets the requirements of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, and should be adopted and implemented throughout Summit County, Ohio.


Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


Section 1: Council hereby approves the 9-1-1 Recommended Implementation Plan dated May, 1986, to the extent that there will be provided to the Village of Richfield the basic service set out in such Plan for the selective routing of emergency calls.

Section 2: That the Clerk of this Council be and is hereby directed to transmit a copy of the within resolution to the County Executive of Summit County, Ohio, immediately upon passage hereof and the approval of the Mayor.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect & be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law
