

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Aaron Company Inc. has given notice to this Village of its intention to not provide collection services pursuant to its agreement under the provisions of Ordinance 58-1985 and,

WHEREAS, an urgent need and real and present emergency exists for the collection of trash and refuse,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for refuse collection services.

Section 2: The specifications for such services now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for such refuse collection services after advertising according to law.

Section 4: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to, pursuant to the provisions of Article VI Section 6.03(6) of the Charter, to purchase collection and trash services without formal bidding and advertising and for the Mayor and Director of Finance to enter into agreements of short duration, for not more than \$5,000.00 and on terms and conditions favorable to this Village and to pay for such services and such authority shall cease and determine upon the signing of an agreement pursuant to Section 3 hereof.

Section 5: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason notice has been given that the collection service will not be provided and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
