

A RESOLUTION DECLARING OCTOBER 16, 1986, "GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES NIGHT" AT THE RUBBER BOWL, UNIVERSITY OF AKRON VS. MURRAY STATE FOOTBALL GAME, AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council wishes the University of Akron football team and its new head coach, Gerry Faust, good luck during the new football season; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that a successful sports program at the University of Akron will be good for the entire region; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1986, the University of Akron vs. Murray State football game will be televised on cable television, and the University seeks to promote the game; and

WHEREAS, this Council would like to assist the University in generating interest and enthusiasm for this and other Akron University football games.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The October 16, 1986 football game between The University of Akron and Murray State University at the Akron Rubber Bowl be declared "GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE NIGHT" in the Village of Richfield.

Section 2: In recognition of this occasion, posters promoting the game shall be permitted to be placed in government buildings in the Village of Richfield.

Section 3: In addition, an announcement of the event shall be permitted to be inserted into Village of Richfield employee paycheck envelopes prior to the date of the game.

Section 4: This Council wishes Gerry Faust and his Akron U. "Zips" the best of luck during the season.


Section 5: A copy of this resolution to be forwarded to Gerry Faust, Coach of the Akron University "Zips".

Section 6: This resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to insure a successful "GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES NIGHT" on October 16, 1986, and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the

Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
