

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ISSUE CHECKS FOR INTERIM TRASH COLLECTION SERVICE BASED ON AN EMERGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Village awarded and entered into an agreement for collection of trash within this Village and

WHEREAS, this Village was given notice that the contractor for such service intended not to perform the agreement for trash collection service and

WHEREAS, this Council under provisions of Ordinance 41-1986 passed emergency legislation to provide authority to enter into an agreement for future trash collection service and

WHEREAS, an emergency situation existed which required the Mayor and Director of Finance to acquire interim trash collection service and payment for such services should be made

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, no less than two-thirds of its members concurring:

- Section 1: Council finds and determines that the failure on the part of contractor to collect trash within this Village created a real and present emergency which arose in connection with the operation of this Village.
- Section 2: Council finds and determines that pursuant to R.C. 735.051 there was no requirement to advertise for competitive bids for trash collection services to be performed on an interim basis, based on the facts set forth in Section 1 hereof.
- Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to issue checks drawing on funds in the proper account or accounts of this Village to pay for such interim collection services created by the facts set forth in Section 1 hereof.
- Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason based on failure of the contractor to provide services and provided this Ordinance receives the

affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
