

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE CLASS A PUMPER FIRE TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the demand put upon the equipment devoted to fire fighting requires this Village to purchase additional equipment,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bidders for the purchase of one (1) Class A Pumper Fire Truck and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement for the purchase of such a fire truck with the lowest and best bidder, after advertising as required by law.

Section 2: The specifications for such fire truck as referred to in Section 1 hereof, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide needed fire fighting equipment and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
