

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 153.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY ELIMINATING THE CATEGORY OF PART TIME PERMANENT EMPLOYEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 153.02 of the Codified Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

153.02 EMPLOYEE CATEGORIES.

Employee categories shall consist of the following:

- (a) Department heads as created by Charter:
 - Director of Finance
 - Director of Public Service
 - Zoning Inspector
 - Chief of Police
 - Chief of Fire Department
 - Director of Public Safety

(b) "Full-time employee" means a person who is employed to work full-time for the Village throughout the entire year.

(c) "Part-time employee" means all other employees not listed herein and not entitled to any benefits other than from the Public Employees Retirement System.

Section 2: Existing 153.02 of the Codified Ordinances is repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to eliminate a category which has no use and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
