AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 25-1985 BY APPROVING
AN AMENDMENT TO THE FORM OF THE CONTRACT AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of
Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 2 of Ordinance 25-1985 is amended to read as
follows:

The form of the contract as amended, now on file
in the office of the Director of Public Service,
is approved and the form of such contract may be
used from time to time and with several political
subdivisions without separate legislative
authority therefore.

Section 2: Existing Section 2 of Ordinance 25-1985 is repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to
provide for an hourly rate of use and provided this
Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds
of the members elected or appointed, it shall take
effect and be in force from and after its approval by
the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest date provided by
law.

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

2) The subdivision shall, within 30 days after such use, pay to the Village the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each hour, or part thereof, of use. The Director of Finance shall provide appropriate billing documents to the subdivisions so as to allow the subdivision sufficient time to pay for such use.
