

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MICHAEL BENZA AND ASSOCIATES INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A BIKE PATH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council finds and determines that the provision of engineering services are personal services and unique and the hiring thereof is not subject to competitive bidding.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Michael Benza and Associates Inc. for the provision of engineering services including the preparation of plans and specifications for the design and construction of a bike path.

Section 3: The fee for such services shall not exceed the sum of \$13,950.00.

Section 4: The form of the contract for such personal services, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is hereby approved.

Section 5: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to take advantage of the construction season and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
