

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE ONE (1) BUS WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of one (1) passenger bus in accordance with law.

Section 2: The specifications for such passenger bus, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for such purchase, after advertising and opening of bids in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to purchase a bus required for the transportation of citizens and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
