

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FUELS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of fuels.

Section 2: The specifications for fuels, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, are hereby approved.

Section 3: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for such fuels after advertising according to law.

Section 4: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to pay for such purchase from funds set aside and appropriated for such purposes.

Section 5: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason the fuels are needed for municipal operation and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
