

A RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO LESTER ISRAEL FOR EXCELLENCE OF SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, he was first elected to Council in November 1975, and his final term expired on December 31, 1983, and,

WHEREAS, his wise counsel and forthright positions on many matters of public concern serve as a guide for present and future members of Council and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to memorialize its appreciation for a job well done,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council expresses its appreciation for excellence of service by Lester Israel as a member of this Council from 1976 to 1983.

Section 2: That Council wishes him well in his future endeavors, and,

Section 3: That the Clerk shall spread this Resolution on the records of this Council and shall post copies thereof at the appropriate places within the Village as a fitting testimonial to Councilman Israel and shall serve upon him a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide a written memorial of service and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
