Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council recognizes the excellence of service provided by Councilman James Miller.

Section 2: Council expresses its gratitude to James Miller for his contributions to the legislative process.

Section 3: That the Clerk shall spread this Resolution on the records of this Council and shall post copies thereof at the appropriate places within the Village as a fitting testimonial to Councilman Miller and shall serve upon him a certified copy of this resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to provide a written memorial of service and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
