

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT RETENTION OF TOLLS ON THE OHIO TURNPIKE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Unless action is taken to continue tolls on the Ohio Turnpike, the roadway will be toll free in December of 1984, and WHEREAS, It is in the public interest to continue tolls for exclusive use of the Ohio Turnpike.

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council determines that the continuation of tolls on the Ohio Turnpike is justified and is in the public interest and council urges that appropriate legislation be enacted to accomplish this result.

Section 2: The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to serve copies of this Resolution on the Ohio Congressional Delegation, Members of the Ohio General Assembly, the Governor, the Ohio Department of Transportation and the Ohio Turnpike Commission.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason time is needed for necessary legislation and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
