

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO SELL ONE (1) 1970 DIAMOND RED RUBBISH TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 61-1983 authorized and directed the Director of Public Service to advertise and sell one refuse packer and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 61-1983 passed December 20, 1983, the Director of Public Service proceeded to advertise for bids for opening on February 23, 1984 and

WHEREAS, no bids were received by the Director of Public Service for the purchase of the packer described in Ordinance 61-1983 and

WHEREAS, there is no need for this Village to keep and retain such packer, the same having a value of \$1,000.00 or less.


Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to sell for the best price and for the best terms, favorable to this Village, one (1) Refuse Packer not needed for municipal purposes, the proceeds of which shall be deposited to the credit of the appropriate fund of this Village.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to sell equipment not required and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
