

A RESOLUTION TO THE BUDGET COMMISSION OF SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO REQUESTING THE INSIDE MILLAGE BE SET AT THE AMOUNT PERMITTED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF OHIO WITHOUT VOTE OF THE ELECTORS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the needs of this Village and the residents for Municipal Services are in excess of the revenues produced and

WHEREAS, the inside millage levied against real property within the Village of Richfield for the Village of Richfield is less than 10 mills, the maximum millage permitted without a vote of the electors and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Summit County has the power to increase the inside millage to 10 mill and costs to the Village have increased by reason of State of Ohio mandated programs and for other reasons.

Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield:

Section 1: The Village of Richfield requests the Budget Commission of Summit County, Ohio, to increase the present level of millage within and for the Village of Richfield from its present level to 10 mills as allowed by the Constitution of the State of Ohio.

Section 2: That the Budget Commission determine that the need of the Village considering the present revenues, present expenditures and required municipal services justify the millage requested in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide evidence of need before the next meeting of the Budget Commission and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
