

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE DEPOSIT OF BRINE, SLUDGE, FRAC-WATER AND OTHER OIL FIELD WASTES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, ESTABLISHING A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 521.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Richfield is enacted as follows:

521.12 Prohibition of Disposal of Oil Field Wastes

- (a) No person, firm or corporation shall dispose of or deposit any brine, sludge, frac-water or other oil field waste within this Village.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Section 2: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to protect the health and safety of citizens of the Village of Richfield and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
