

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF FEDERAL LEGISLATION TO ALLOW FEDERAL FUNDS TO BE SPENT FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT WITHIN THE CUYAHOGA VALLEY NATIONAL RECREATION AREA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


Section 1: The Council of the Village of Richfield urges the elected members of Congress to support Federal legislation which would authorize and permit Federal Funds for improvement of public roadways within the Cuyahoga Valley National Recreation Area.


Section 2: The Clerk shall transmit a copy of this Resolution 32-1984 to U.S. Senators John Glenn and Howard Metzenbaum and Congressman John Seiberling.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide funds for needed maintenance on public highways and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
