

RESOLUTION NO. 27 -2013

Offered by All of Council

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A CERTAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT RESCUE VEHICLE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL THE VEHICLE THROUGH COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to declare a certain Fire Department rescue vehicle as surplus property that is no longer of useful service to the Village and wishes to authorize the sale of said vehicle through competitive bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the following vehicle previously used by the Village Fire Department is hereby declared surplus property, no longer of useful service to the Village: 2006 Heavy Rescue Vehicle VIN: 2NKMHZ8X27M177032.
- SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to sell the above-listed vehicle by competitive bidding in accordance with Ohio law.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to dispose of the unneeded, surplus vehicle for the efficient operation of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
